Built in the 19th century on the Muros e Noia estuary, this is the largest tidal mill in Spain and one of the most important in Europe.

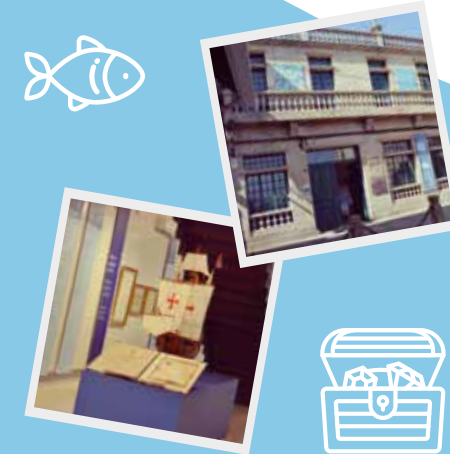
